All students in grades 6-8 in the state will be taking the M-STEP test and 8th grade will be taking the PSAT also. M-STEP and PSAT scores are used to grade each individual school. Please encourage your student to perform to the best of his/her ability as the scores are a source of pride for every student, every class, parents, and the Kelloggsville community.

It is very important that your student be in attendance the entire day on testing dates. Please try to avoid scheduling any appointments. This is especially important because time for make-up assessments is limited.

The testing schedule is as follows:

8th Grade testing dates: 4/10 (PSAT 8/9) and 4/11 (M-Step)

7th Grade testing dates: 4/17 (M-Step)

6th Grade testing dates: 4/18 (M-Step)
