

HIGH SCHOOL (GRADES 9-12):

All high school courses will be presented and monitored by Kelloggsville teachers and delivered through the Schoology learning management system. The course content is presented through APEX learning and will follow Kelloggsville curriculum maps. Students are required to have the following 18 credits for graduation:

- 4 English credits
- 4 Math credits (must have Algebra I,II, and Geometry and 1 more class in the final year)
- 3 Science credits (must have Biology, and either Chemistry or Physics)
- 3 Social Studies credits (all courses listed below)
- **2 Foreign Language credits** (or a combination of 1 foreign language and an art)
- 1 Visual, Performing, and Applied Arts credit
- 1 Physical Education & Health credit.
