INFORMATION & REPORTS

A. <u>Band/School Trip to St. Ignace Review</u>

KHS Band Director, Mr. Anderson, shared an update with the Board on the recent trip that a group of 38 band students traveled to Curtis, Michigan, to participate in their 4th of July parade. Mr. Anderson was contacted by the Chamber of Commerce back in the spring, asking if the band would consider participating in an all-expense paid trip to the U.P., to perform in the town's holiday parade. With the Board's approval, band members, staff, and parent chaperones traveled to St. Ignace to spend the night, allowing students to have free time visiting many of the local attractions, etc. The following morning, they then traveled to the small town of Curtis, MI., which held a very large celebration that 15,000-20,000 visitors attended. The band participated in the parade and held a mini concert before traveling back to Kelloggsville the same day. Mr. Anderson shared that he received several compliments on the behavior and politeness of our students and how they were actually treated as celebrities and were thanked for their willingness to participate. He also noted that three (3) KHS band students will be participating in the Michigan Ambassadors of Music program next summer, which is a parent-paid program that celebrates talented student performers from across the state/nation, giving them the chance to both preform abroad while experiencing destinations across Europe.

B. New Employee Orientation

Mr. Alcorn shared highlights of the new staff orientation that was held on August 7th. A variety of information was shared with new instructional staff and other district employees, to welcome them to the Kville school family.
