Reconfirmation Meeting for December 2020

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:
Kelloggsville Public Schools will continue to offer only virtual instruction for students until Tuesday, January 19. There is a possibility that this method of instruction will be extended based on the COVID-19 situation in the community.
Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:
Pre-Kindergarten: virtual
Elementary (Grades K - 5): virtual
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): virtual
High School (Grades 9 - 12): virtual
Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:
No in-person instruction for any students due to the pandemic.
Document Public Comments:
Summary of comments posted on the district's Facebook page- Some parents were appreciative of the district's decision to remain virtual until January 19, mentioning the well-being of their child being their primary concern. There were other parents that disagreed with this decision, citing other districts that were offering in-school instruction for K-8 students.
