# Option 1

## Regular classroom instruction

### Instructional Design

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This is our in classroom instruction which will occur face-to-face with the following COVID-19 focused safety protocols.

This Option will be available while the state of Michigan is in Phases 4, 5, & 6. Please note that the following protocols may be updated throughout the year to create a more safe environment for students and staff.

# Option 1

## Regular classroom instruction

### Facial Coverings

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- Required at all times for:
  - Teachers & staff members
  - ALL students
  - The very few visitors to a district building
- Kindergarten-5th grade students will need to wear coverings when traveling in common areas (including hallways & playgrounds)
  - Also during small group instruction, reading intervention groups for example.

# Option 1

## Regular classroom instruction

### Classrooms

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- Students tables & desks will be spaced out to promote social distancing.
- Student tables & desks will also be facing the same direction to limit the variations on the flow of traffic.
- Desks & tables will be wiped down between class periods at secondary buildings.
- K-5th students will stay in one room for the day. Exceptions made for small group interventions.
  - Specials teachers will rotate to classrooms
- Teachers will practice social distancing with students whenever possible.
  - Plexiglass dividers for intervention supports

# Option 1

## Regular classroom instruction

### Meals

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- K-5: Breakfast and lunch will be eaten in the classroom.
- 6-12: Breakfast and lunch eaten in cafeteria with increased distance between students.
- 54th Street Academy: Breakfast and lunch will be eaten in the classroom.

# Option 1

## Regular classroom instruction

### Screening

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- Students will have their temperature checked upon arrival to school by staff members in PPE.
- Each building will have a designated quarantine room should students or staff members exhibit COVID symptoms during the school day.
- KPS buildings will follow all recommendations from the Kent County Health Department concerning how to handle situations where students or staff members test positive for COVID-19.
- KPS staff members will conduct daily self-examinations.

# Option 1

## Regular classroom instruction

### Cleaning

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- Enhanced cleaning of frequently touched surfaces throughout the day with disinfecting wipes by building staff members.
- All classrooms will be thoroughly sanitized on a nightly basis using a Dermal-Tech electro-hygiene system that will be delivered through a mist.

# Option 2

## Online Learning

### Instructional Learning Grades 4th-12th

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- Instruction will occur via the Odysseyware platform.
- Kelloggsville teachers will monitor and assist students via digital software and email.

# Option 2

## Online Learning

### Instructional Learning

#### Grades K-3rd

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- Instruction will be given by Kelloggsville teaching staff.
- This instruction will mirror classroom instruction.
  - There will be live and recorded lessons for students & families to view.

# Option 2

## Online Learning

### Details for ALL grades

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- Attendance will be monitored on a daily basis by student login and work completion.
- Students may be required to take assessments in person at school.
- Students that select the online option must remain online for the full 9-week marking period.
  - Online curriculum will be aligned with in-school instruction if the student wishes to move to regular classroom instruction the next 9-week marking period.

# Option 2

## Online Learning

### Details for ALL grades

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- Kelloggsville will provide students with an assigned Chromebook and charger.
- Kelloggsville will assist families that are in need of high speed internet.
- Parents must sign-up their students for Virtual Learning by August 14th
  - A Virtual Learning Orientation must be attended by all Virtual Learning students & parents.
