Reconfirmation Meeting for November 2020

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:
Due to a spike in COVID-19 cases, Kelloggsville Public Schools moved to 100% virtual instruction on November 11, 2020. At the present time, the plan is to continue with this model until January 4, 2021.
Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:
Pre-Kindergarten: virtual
Elementary (Grades K - 5): virtual
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): virtual
High School (Grades 9 - 12): virtual
Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:
Due to the increasing number of COVID-19 cases in the county, Kelloggsville Public School is not offering any in-person instruction at this time.
