Math Tutoring Program for Kelloggsville Students

Online Targeted Math Tutoring Program for students in grades 6-12.

If your child is a 6th-10th grade student struggling in math (up to Algebra 1), this is an opportunity for him/her to receive 1 to 1 tutoring support through a program called <u>The Grand Valley State University K-12 Connect Program</u>.

The program will provide virtual, one-on-one tutoring, starting the week of March 25, 2024 and run to the week of May 20, 2024.

Grand Valley State University will provide trained, virtual tutors that will assist your child in understanding math concepts being taught in their regular math classroom. All the tutors in this program have passed thorough background checks. Tutoring can take place during times that fit with family schedules on weekday evenings or weekends. Students will access the online tutoring program using their Chromebooks provided by Kelloggsville Public Schools.

Important- Students must commit to attending (3) 30 minute sessions per week.

No cost to parents and students! Kelloggsville Public Schools will use 23g MI Kids Back on Track grant funding to pay for the program!
