

Central Kelloggsville Goals and Activities 2022-2023

- 1. Reading Goal: 50% of all 3rd, 4th, & 5th grade Central Kelloggsville students will meet or exceed their projected growth on the Reading NWEA assessment for Fall 2022 to Spring 2023.
 - Activity: All 3rd, 4th, & 5th grade students will engage in ELA Read Alouds & Writing Instruction, Shared Reading, and Differentiated Reading Instruction blocks through Bookworms.
 - b. Activity: All 3rd, 4th, & 5th grade teachers will:
 - i. read above-grade level text, modeling inferential thinking and comprehension strategies. Focused grammar instruction and related written responses will require students to write about what they're reading.
 - ii. provide students with grade-level texts to read out loud with support of the teacher to foster fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension.
 - iii. use assessments to group students and provide targeted instruction to help them excel.
 - c. Activity: All 3rd, 4th, & 5th grade students that are below grade level in reading will receive small group instruction on reading intervention.
- 2. Math Goal: 50% of all 3rd, 4th, & 5th grade Central Kelloggsville students will meet or exceed their projected growth on the Math NWEA assessment for Fall 2022 to Spring 2023.
 - Activity: All 3rd, 4th, & 5th grade students will be taught math through the EnVision Math program that combines problem-based learning and visual learning to deepen students' conceptual understanding.
 - b. Activity: All 3rd, 4th, & 5th grade teachers will use EnVision Math which focuses on deep conceptual math understanding aided by visual models, student-centered projects, 3-act tasks (an engaging & perplexing Act One, an information & solution seeking Act Two, and a solution discussion & solution revealing Act Three) and personalized learning.
 - c. Activity: Additional math support will be offered through tutoring before and after school.
- 3. Whole Child Goal (SEL): All 3rd, 4th, & 5th grade students will increase their score on the universal screener on Social Emotional Learning from Fall 2022 to Spring 2023.
 - a. Activity: All 3rd, 4th, & 5th grade students will receive a holistic approach to social emotional learning called Second Step. Classroom lessons will be delivered by the school counselor.
 - b. Activity: All 3rd, 4th, & 5th grade students will participate in a universal screener to identify areas of need pertaining to social and emotional growth.
 - c. Activity: All staff will participate in PBIS/SOAR and CHAMPS to promote a positive behavior environment.
