In case of emergency or your child becoming sick here at school, it is essential that the office have updated phone numbers. This also includes your emergency contacts.

Please notify the office if there is a change in any of these numbers.

Attendance:

Consistent attendance at school is extremely important to the educational growth of all children. When a student is late to school or picked up early it affects their learning progress. Kelloggsville Public Schools are required to report all tardies (including late arrivals and early departures) to the Kent County office of truancy when chronic absenteeism is occurring. Please make all efforts to make appointments outside of the regularly scheduled school day.

Picking Up Students Early:

We realize that there are times when picking up your child early is necessary due to important events like going to the doctor or dentist's office. However, this should not happen on a regular basis. It is important that your child attend school for the entire day. All students leaving early will receive a tardy for that day. Repeated incidents of tardiness will result in a truancy referral.

Non-Prescription Medicine:

If your child will be taking over the counter medication, you will need to fill out a non-prescription medicine form. We do not provide medication; you will need to bring the medicine in its original container to the office along with any measuring cups/spoons.

Kelloggsville App:

Did you know that Kelloggsville Public Schools has its own App.? The App. Will connect you directly with the district's website and provide you with all the information that you need! Simply go to the Apple App. Store of Google Play and type in Kelloggsville Public Schools!

Weather Alert:

As fall returns to winter, remember to send your students to school with the appropriate winter attire. We will go outside unless the temperature drops below 10 degrees. We will go out in snow. Coats are required for students once the temperature drops below 50 degrees. PLEASE write your child's name on the inside of snow pants, boots, hats and gloves if there is a place to do so. Thank you.
